Updated policy

We would like to draw your attention to an update to the policy regarding medical conditions and medicines. We have added the following information to ensure you are aware that we are not able to administer antibiotics in school:

We are not able to administer antibiotics to pupils. Guidance states that antibiotics should not routinely be given in school. Three times a day antibiotics such as amoxicillin should be given in the morning before school/setting, immediately after school and at bedtime. If your child is prescribed a course of antibiotics and you require guidance or support as to how they are best administered, please contact the school office.
